  - Note: Your audition selection need not be opera or classical music, but must be published music, approximately five minutes in length.
- 2. Official proof of your grade point average issued by your school and sealed
- 3. Two letters of recommendation:
  - one from a high school guidance counselor or music teacher
  - one from a community or business leader
- 4. One copy of the sheet music for your audition piece.
